

Rules of participation in events organized by BAILAME applicable during SARS-CoV-2 pandemic

Due to the necessity of protecting from SARS-CoV-2 virus infection and the safety procedures introduced by the sanitary regime, the Organizer introduces the following rules applicable during BailaMe Cracow Bachata Festival 2021 – Summer Fiesta Edition which will take place on 06.08-09.08.2021.

These rules are created based on regulations issued by Minister of Culture and National Heritage, the Ministry of Development and the Chief Sanitary Inspector in respect of the requirements of the sanitary regime during SARS-CoV-2 pandemic

- Participation in the event BailaMe Cracow Bachata Festival 2021 – Summer Fiesta Edition is equivalent to the acceptance of the Rules and Regulations of the Festival and Rules of participation in events organized by BAILAME applicable during SARS-CoV-2 pandemic. All rules are available on the website: www.bailame.pl.
- Participant is obliged to get familiar with the Regulations before purchasing a ticket
- Participation in the Festival's events is subject to a written declaration about the participant's health condition. Entry is prohibited to participants who knowingly:
 - are infected or suspect an infection
 - are quarantined
 - are subject to epidemic surveillance.
- Declaration form (to be downloaded [HERE](#)) will be available at ticket sales points during Festival. Before entering to Festival, participant needs to fill in the declaration form. Participants who fail to fill in forms will not be allowed to the event.
- Participant can download the declaration form before, but the form must be filled in, signed and handed over to staff at the spot.
- Supplying your personal data (First Name, Last Name, address, phone number, email address) is equivalent to your consent for data processing by the organizers according to the GDPR policy for a period of two weeks from the event and possible transfer of this data to the authorized bodies and institutions.
- Organizers reserve the right to deny entry to the event to person with visible symptoms of infection (cough, shortness of breath, fever)
- Participants are obliged to wear face masks and to observe a social distancing standard of 1.5 metres and in case of queues - 2 meters.
- Participant needs to bring his/her own personal protective equipment and is obliged to use it during the event by covering mouth and nose.
- Participants are obliged to disinfect hands before entering the event venue. Hand disinfectants will be available at the spot.
- Staff members will have personal protective equipment
- The amount of people is limited due to the sanitary regime.
- Participants are obliged to follow the safety rules, safety signs and to follow orders of the staff members.
